

He called the storm “Reset.”


"Reset could wipe out everything.

They reset PUBLIC SCHOOL; many taught their children at home.


They reset their PRIORITIES with purpose.

(Proverbs 19:17)


Honey watched the people pray and work in

“We need a team to buy wheat, oil, wine, and salt, and honey.


We can pay off our debt and get gold and silver.

On July 24, 2023, the Treaty of Lausanne, which dismantled the Ottoman Empire, will expire. On July 24, 2020, Turkey converted the Hagia Sophia, one of the oldest Byzantine churches, into a mosque, announced their intentions to resurrect the Ottoman Empire and drive the Jewish people from Jerusalem.

On September 15, 2022, five red heifers were flown to Israel. The Temple Institute amassed all the sacred items required to rebuild the Temple. In the Fall of 2023, if one of the red heifers pass inspection, temple sacrifices may be re-instituted.

On April 8, 2024, the United States will again experience a total eclipse. This solar event intersects with the eclipse that took place seven years prior in a place called "Little Egypt". Some Rabbis speculate this is a sign that the Almighty is ingathering the Jewish people from America.
